Anne Kenneally Hynes, a proud graduate of East Bridgewater High School's Class of 1950, was a teacher and librarian at her alma mater for more than four decades; she passed away in February, 2011. Selection Criteria

Beginning with the Class of 2014, one or more awards will be made by the Anne Kenneally Hynes Memorial Scholarship Committee, to East Bridgewater residents who are current or recent high school graduates accepted to an accredited school of higher learning. Recipients will meet the following criteria (listed in order of importance):

- a) Demonstrates humanitarian spirit, as evidenced by compassion, humility, empathy for others
- b) Academic excellence, as evidenced by scholastic record, high level of effort, strong motivation toward achieving academic/career goals
- c) Evidence of service to school and community
- d) Financial need
